Introduction

- ▶ We can't earn Heaven saved by God's grace/mercy
- But there are conditions we must meet

Jesus' Final Instructions

- Matthew 28:18-20:
 - Teach
 - Baptize
 - Teach
- Mark 16:15-16:
 - Preach
 - Belief
 - Baptism
 - Salvation
- Luke 24:47
 - Repentance
 - Forgiveness
- Combination of all three accounts:
 - Preach/teach
 - Belief
 - Repentance
 - Baptism
 - Forgiven/Saved
 - Teach

Day of Pentecost

- Every component of Jesus' final instructions is found in Acts 2:
 - Peter PREACHED
 - Told them to "know for certain" that Jesus is the Christ BELIEF.
 - They asked what they needed to do. Peter said, "REPENT...and be BAPTIZED...for FORGIVENESS."
 - Then they "continued steadfastly in the apostle's TEACHING"

What About Confessing Christ?

- Why isn't confession included in this information?
- Consider Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch:
 - Philip preached Jesus to him, and he asked to be baptized
 - Philip said, "If you believe... you may," not, "If you confess... you may"
- Confession is necessary to communicate one is a believer
